Benjamin Goss of Denver, Colorado, a business professional working in Jefferson County Colorado, declared his intent today to run for nomination as the [Gubernatorial Candidate](#) for the [American Constitution Party](#).

As the third largest party in the nation, the [Constitution Party](#) stands at the edge of a precipice in which the political landscape is undergoing massive upheaval. In the face of mounting public dissatisfaction with the larger parties, Democrat and Republican, many Americans want another option. Our rights as Americans, which have been so deeply engraved in the granite of the US Constitution in the Bill of Rights, now face an onslaught of politically catastrophic redefinition.

The reality is that the social and political elite who do NOT represent the average, freedom-loving American, are entirely focused on taking as much control as they can *by redefining the meaning of the words* contained in the Bill of Rights.

Coupling the massive raft of legislation that has been passed over the course of the last 30 years with nearly 100 years of social jurisprudence in the US Courts, in defiance of the Constitution our rights have been abridged already.

[It's about time](#) someone in government showed concern for our children's and grandchildren's future.

They don't need to take rights away as that would be too obvious, instead all they need is to redefine the scope, the breadth and the depth, of what those freedoms *mean*. [It's about time](#) that someone means it when they say, "Stop."

America needs to realize that by and large we are both geographically and politically outside the DC Beltway. The reality is that citizens have very little real influence on what is crafted inside that classic highway. We call on all Coloradoans, and all Americans, to not allow themselves to be defined by such labels as Democrat, Republican, Independent, Tea Partier, and so on. It seems that, for most politicians, the majority of their effort is spent simply protecting their own influential positions rather than their constituents. It's time for each of us to engage with individual candidates, asking them to define their positions and records, and determine if they are truly committed to protecting our rights as citizens.
